## 2018 HOLIDAY RESIDENTIAL GARBAGE SCHEDULE

<b>January 1</b>	<b>New Year's Holiday</b>	No change in residential garbage pickup.
<b>January 15</b>	<b>Martin Luther King Jr. Day</b>	No change in residential garbage pickup.
<b>March 30</b>	<b>Good Friday</b>	Friday March 30 <sup>th</sup> garbage picked up Monday April 2 <sup>nd</sup> .
<b>May 28</b>	<b>Memorial Day</b>	No change in residential garbage pickup.
<b>July 4</b>	<b>Independence Day</b>	Wednesday July 4 <sup>th</sup> garbage picked up Thursday July 5 <sup>th</sup> . Thursday July 5 <sup>th</sup> garbage picked up Friday July 6 <sup>th</sup> . Friday July 6 <sup>th</sup> garbage picked up Monday July 9 <sup>th</sup> .
<b>September 3</b>	<b>Labor Day</b>	No change in residential garbage pickup.
<b>November 22, 23</b>	<b>Thanksgiving</b>	Thursday November 22 <sup>nd</sup> garbage picked up Friday November 23 <sup>rd</sup> . Friday November 23 <sup>rd</sup> garbage picked up Monday November 26 <sup>th</sup> .
<b>December 24, 25</b>	<b>Christmas</b>	Tuesday December 25 <sup>th</sup> garbage picked up Wednesday Dec. 26 <sup>th</sup> . Wednesday December 26 <sup>th</sup> garbage picked up Thursday Dec. 27 <sup>th</sup> . Thursday December 27 <sup>th</sup> garbage picked up Friday Dec. 28 <sup>th</sup> . Friday December 28 <sup>th</sup> garbage picked up Monday Dec. 31 <sup>st</sup> .

### BRUSH COLLECTION

Residents receive once a month brush collection service. Although the schedule for brush is the same as junk, they cannot be mixed together in a pile. Each is emptied into a different place. After separating the brush from the junk waste, remember to stack brush near the curb with the butt end of the limbs facing the street. (No longer than 12 foot lengths.)

### JUNK COLLECTION

Junk is appliances and all the big items that you can't fit in your garbage can. Depending on what the items are, you may have to separate them too. Some things are recyclable like tires, cardboard boxes and many products made of steel. Other items like old toys, furniture, and small kitchen appliances can be placed in a pile in the front along side the tires (no rims) and metals. No paint or food waste can be mixed in the junk.

### LEAF COLLECTION

The Spring Loose Leaf Collection begins on March 15<sup>th</sup> in the red zone. All zones will be collected one time in the spring. The Fall Loose Leaf Collection begins Monday, October 15<sup>th</sup> in the Red Zone continuing through November and December. The Fall schedule for leaf pickup is the same as brush/junk collection except for January. In January, the City will do one last leaf collection starting January 2<sup>nd</sup>. Citizens must have any remaining loose leaves at the curb by January 2<sup>nd</sup> for the last collection. Place loose leaves in the front yard, not in a ditch or drainage system. This could clog up your storm drain.
