2017 HOLIDAY RESIDENTIAL GARBAGE SCHEDULE

January 2	New Year's Holiday	No change in residential garbage pickup.
January 16	Martin Luther King Jr. Day	No change in residential garbage pickup.
April 14	Good Friday	Friday April 14 th garbage picked up following Monday, April 17 th .
May 29	Memorial Day	No change in residential garbage pickup.
July 4	Independence Day	Tuesday, July 4 th garbage picked up Wednesday, July 5 th . Wednesday, July 5 th garbage picked up Thursday, July 6 th . Thursday, July 6 th garbage picked up Friday, July 7 th . Friday, July 7 th garbage picked up Monday, July 10 th .
September 4	Labor Day	No change in residential garbage pickup.
November 23, 24	Thanksgiving	Thursday November 23 rd garbage picked up Friday November 24 th . Friday November 24 th garbage picked up following Monday November 27 th .
December 22, 25	Christmas	No change in residential garbage pickup.

BRUSH COLLECTION

Residents receive once a month brush collection service. Although the schedule for brush is the same as junk, they cannot be mixed together in a pile. Each is emptied into a different place. After separating the brush from the junk waste, remember to stack brush near the curb with the butt end of the limbs facing the street. (No longer than 12 foot lengths.)

JUNK COLLECTION

Junk is appliances and all the big items that you can't fit in your garbage can. Depending on what the items are, you may have to separate them too. Some things are recyclable like tires, cardboard boxes and many products made of steel. Other items like old toys, furniture, and small kitchen appliances can be placed in a pile in the front along side the tires (no rims) and metals. No paint or food waste can be mixed in the junk.

LEAF COLLECTION

The Spring Loose Leaf Collection begins on March 15th in the red zone. All zones will be collected one time in the spring. The Fall Loose Leaf Collection begins Monday, October 16th in the Red Zone continuing through November and December. The Fall schedule for leaf pickup is the same as brush/junk collection except for January. In January, the City will do one last leaf collection starting January 2nd. Citizens must have any remaining loose leaves at the curb by January 2nd for the last collection. Place loose leaves in the front yard, not in a ditch or drainage system. This could clog up your storm drain.
