FOOD PANTRIES IN BLOUNT COUNTY

Updated Details:

- > Louisville Christian Assistance Center: They are open to any Blount Co residents. They have 11 parking spots designated for residents who need food. Residents are to stay in their cars. LCAC staff/volunteer will come to the car, greet and get food items to them from their car.
- Chilhowee Baptist Center: They can support food supports by APPOINTMENT ONLY for safety and ability to prepare the bags of food needed. The residents are asked to provide a photo ID and proof of Blount Co. residency. They do have their Baptist Church affiliates conducting food distribution events throughout the county. Please also inquire about those events when calling.
- **Fairview United Methodist Church**: They are giving out food by drive up only. They just need proof of Blount County residency.
- Community Food Connection: Recorded message verifies the days and times above to receive a prepack food items. Need proof of Blount Co. residency.
- **CROSS Ministries**: They are primarily a resource for residents in the Seymour area. They are serving by drive up only.
- Manna Outreach Ministries: They are open and serving Blount Co. residents by drive through only. Previous participants need their photo ID, while new participants need photo ID and a piece of mail from their residence.
- Church of the Cove: They are located very close to the Sevier Co. line, so let folks know that their location is not as close as other Blount Co. food pantries and may use more gas to get to their location, but that they are very happy to serve anyone who comes on the 1st Saturday of the month from 9-11am. They are a Second Harvest distribution site, with some supplemental food items as the church can support. They do need a contact telephone #, if there is a food recall notification. This will be a drive through distribution.
- Maryville Church of Christ: They can support by APPOINTMENT ONLY. Please tell residents to leave a message, if they get the church recording and the administrative staff will return the call and set up a time for pick up. They are fully stocked and able to help. They prebag the food and set outside the church door and watch for the resident to pick up.
- Second Harvest: Due to community need, they have adjusted their processes to be able to possibly assist residents on an individual basis, yet please call 865-521-0000 to find out their process and hours. They have been extremely responsive to provide food for mass distribution efforts. Second Harvest is located at 136 Harvest Lane, Maryville, TN 37801.
