Each zone lasts several working days, but items will only be picked up one time during the zone. **Bulk/junk may only be placed at curb 3 days prior to the beginning of your zone collection date. Be sure to place items at curb before your zone begins.** Failure to do so could result in missed collection. City holidays are bolded in **BLACK**.

2024 HOLIDAY RESIDENTIAL GARBAGE SCHEDULE

January 1	New Year's Day	No change in garbage schedule this week
January 15	Martin Luther King Jr. Day	No change in garbage schedule this week
March 29	Good Friday	Friday, March 29 th garbage picked up on Monday, April 1 st
May 27	Memorial Day	No change in garbage schedule this week
July 4	Independence Day Holiday	Thursday, July 4 th garbage will be picked up Friday July 5 th and Friday, July 5 th garbage will be picked up Monday, July 8 th .
September 2	Labor Day	No change in garbage schedule this week
November 28, 29	Thanksgiving Holiday	Thursday, November 28 th garbage picked up Friday November 29 th , Friday, November 29 th garbage picked up Monday, December 2 nd
December 24, 25	Christmas Holiday	Tuesday, December 24 th garbage will be picked up that day. Wednesday, December 25 th through Friday December 27 th garbage will be moved one business day forward .

BRUSH COLLECTION

Residents receive once a month brush collection service. Although the schedule for brush is the same as junk, please keep the brush pile separate from the junk pile. Brush is emptied at a different place than junk. After separating the brush from the junk waste, remember to stack brush near the curb with the butt end of the limbs facing the street. (No longer than 12-foot lengths.)

JUNK COLLECTION

Junk is all the big items that you can't fit in your garbage can up to and including appliances and furniture. Items should be separated by the type of item. Please keep recyclable items like cardboard boxes and many products made of steel separate. Other items like furniture and small kitchen appliances can be placed at the curb. No paint or food waste can be mixed in the junk. Please call our sanitation dept. at (865) 273-3302 for tire removal.

LEAF COLLECTION

The Spring Loose Leaf Collection begins on March 15th in the red zone. All zones will be collected one time in the spring. The Fall Loose Leaf Collection begins October 15th in the Red Zone continuing through November and December. The Fall schedule for leaf pickup is the same as brush/junk collection except for January. In January, the City will do one last leaf collection starting Monday, January 6th, 2025. Citizens must have any remaining loose leaves at the curb by Sunday, January 5th, 2025 for the last collection. Please put loose leaves in the front yard, not in a ditch or drainage system. This could clog up your storm drain.
