Thereupon, the Mayor declared the Council in session for a Public Hearing at 6:56 p.m. regarding an ordinance establishing standards for short-term rentals units by adding a Section 14-211 (29) to and amending portions of Section 14-202 of the Zoning and Land Use Ordinance, Title 14, Chapter 2 of the Maryville Municipal Code. There were no further comments so the Mayor declared the hearing closed.

Thereupon, the Mayor declared the Council in session for a Public Hearing at 6:59 regarding an ordinance to amend the official zoning map of the City of Maryville, Tennessee by rezoning property off of Legends Way from Business and Transportation to Residential. There were no further comments so the Mayor declared the hearing closed.

Thereupon, Council convened for regular business at 7:00 p.m. when the following members were present and answered roll call: Mayor Tom Taylor presiding, Councilmen Fred Metz, Joe Swann and Andy White. Also present were Assistant City Manager Roger Campbell, City Recorder Sherri Phillips, and City Attorney Melanie Davis. Councilman Tommy Hunt was absent. The Mayor declared a quorum to be present.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING PARTS OF CITY CODE TITLE VII, CHAPTER 7: FIREWORKS REGULATED.
