Requirements Of Permit Holder

A Right-of-Way excavation permit will be required for any person, firm, corporation, public or private utility, association, or others to make any cut or excavation in any street, curb, alley, or public right-of-way in the city limits. Anyone undertaking such activity shall comply with the following criteria:

1. Permit holder must comply with Excavation and Cuts Ordinance (Title 16, Chapter 2) which provides for the proper restorations within the public right-of-way. All backfill methods and materials should comply with the City of Maryville Public Works Standards.
2. Permit holder must comply with the Soil Erosion and Sedimentation Control Ordinance (Title 4, Chapter 9) and will be required to keep sediment, debris, mud, etc. from the streets by properly cleaning the street during and after construction is complete in order to avoid a hazardous traffic situation.
3. All work within the pavement or near the traveled way will require traffic control measures to be used pursuant to the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices. These guidelines are strictly a minimum requirement and additional measures may be required by the City prior to or during construction. These may include additional signing, flagmen, police officers, restricted construction hours, etc.
