City of Maryville Regional Wastewater Treatment Plant Conditions of Septage Receiving Station Use

1. The septage receiving station must be kept clean. It is the responsibility of the septage transporter to clean the septage receiving station after each discharge.
2. In the event that the card reader system at the septage receiving station is out of service, the septage transporter must report to an operator and record the required information on the log inside the Regional Wastewater Treatment Plant PRIOR to discharge at the septage receiving station.
3. Use of the septage receiving station is restricted to daylight hours only, seven day a week.
4. In the event that card is lost or stolen, notify Regional Wastewater Treatment Plant management as soon as possible.

I understand the above conditions concerning use of the City of Maryville Regional Wastewater Treatment Plant septage receiving station. I also understand that violation of these conditions may result in suspension or revocation of my Septage Transporter Permit.
